2. Who are we

Kyowa Kirin Taiwan Co., Ltd. is part of the Kyowa Kirin Group. The Group is made up of different legal entities, details of which can be found here and which may be updated from time to time. When we say 'Kyowa Kirin', 'we' or 'us' in this privacy notice, we are referring to the relevant company in the Kyowa Kirin Group responsible for processing your personal data.

Kyowa Kirin is a "data controller" of the personal data that we hold about you. This means that we are responsible for deciding how we hold and use personal information about you. We are required under data protection legislation to notify you of the information contained in this privacy notice.

3. What information do we collect?

Personal data, or personal information, means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data).

This privacy notice covers the information we collect through this website which includes:

- Name, contact information, nationality, professional information and login credentials provided directly by you: we collect the aforementioned details when you register an account with us.

4. How we might use your information?

If you ask us to delete your information in accordance with your rights set out below, we will retain basic information on a suppression list to record your request and to avoid sending you unwanted materials in the future.

6. How we might share your information with

We will NOT sell your personal data to any third parties.

We may share your personal information with any member of our group where we have a legal basis for doing so. We may share your information with selected third parties including:

- Analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of our site.
- Business contractors in relation to the maintenance of this website.
- IT service providers.
- If we merge with another organisation or form a new entity, your personal data may be transferred to that new entity.

We may disclose your personal information to third parties to:

- Comply with any court order or other legal obligation or when data is requested by our regulators or by government agencies or law enforcement agencies or is required by any stock exchange rules where a member of the Kyowa Kirin Group is listed;
- Enforce or apply our terms of use and any other agreements;
- Protect the rights, property, or safety of us, our employees or others.

8. Your rights
